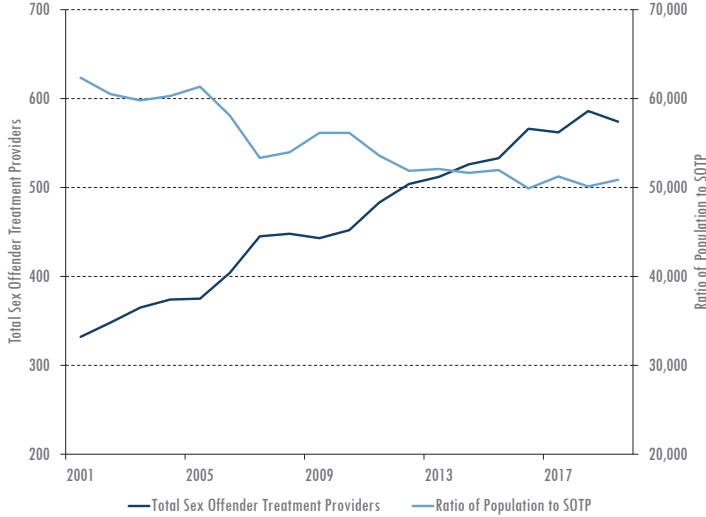




Sex Offender Treatment Providers | 2019

SOTP Growth Trends



In 2019, there were 574 actively licensed Sex Offender Treatment Providers (SOTPs) in Texas.

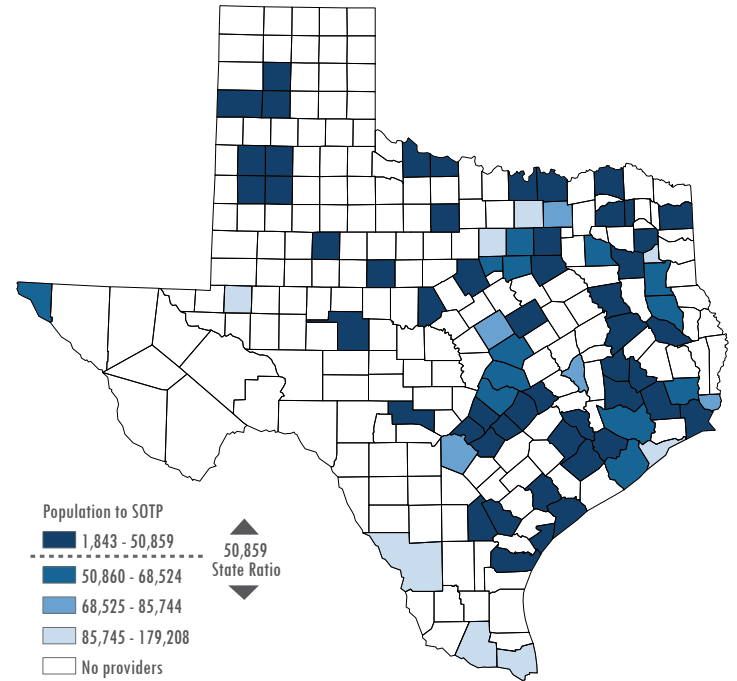
- This number represented a 9.1% increase since 2014 and a 29.6% increase since 2009.
- Relative to population growth, the size of the SOTP workforce has improved by 9.4% over the past 10 years.

- In 2019, 17.6% of SOTPs were aged 40 or younger.
- Within 10 years, 58.0% of SOTPs will be at or approaching retirement age.

SOTPs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 8.7% difference between the number of SOTPs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas, the percent difference was 70.0%.
