Samples of fish taken from the Brazos River in the area covered by ADV-1 indicate that the levels

of dioxins and furans have decreased to an acceptable level. Additional samples did not indicate

any other contaminants of concern. Therefore, the fish consumption advisory for the Brazos River

and all contiguous waters south and east of the FM 521 Bridge near Brazoria to the mouth of the

river is hereby rescinded.

This advisory rescinds ADV-1 issued on September 19, 1990.
