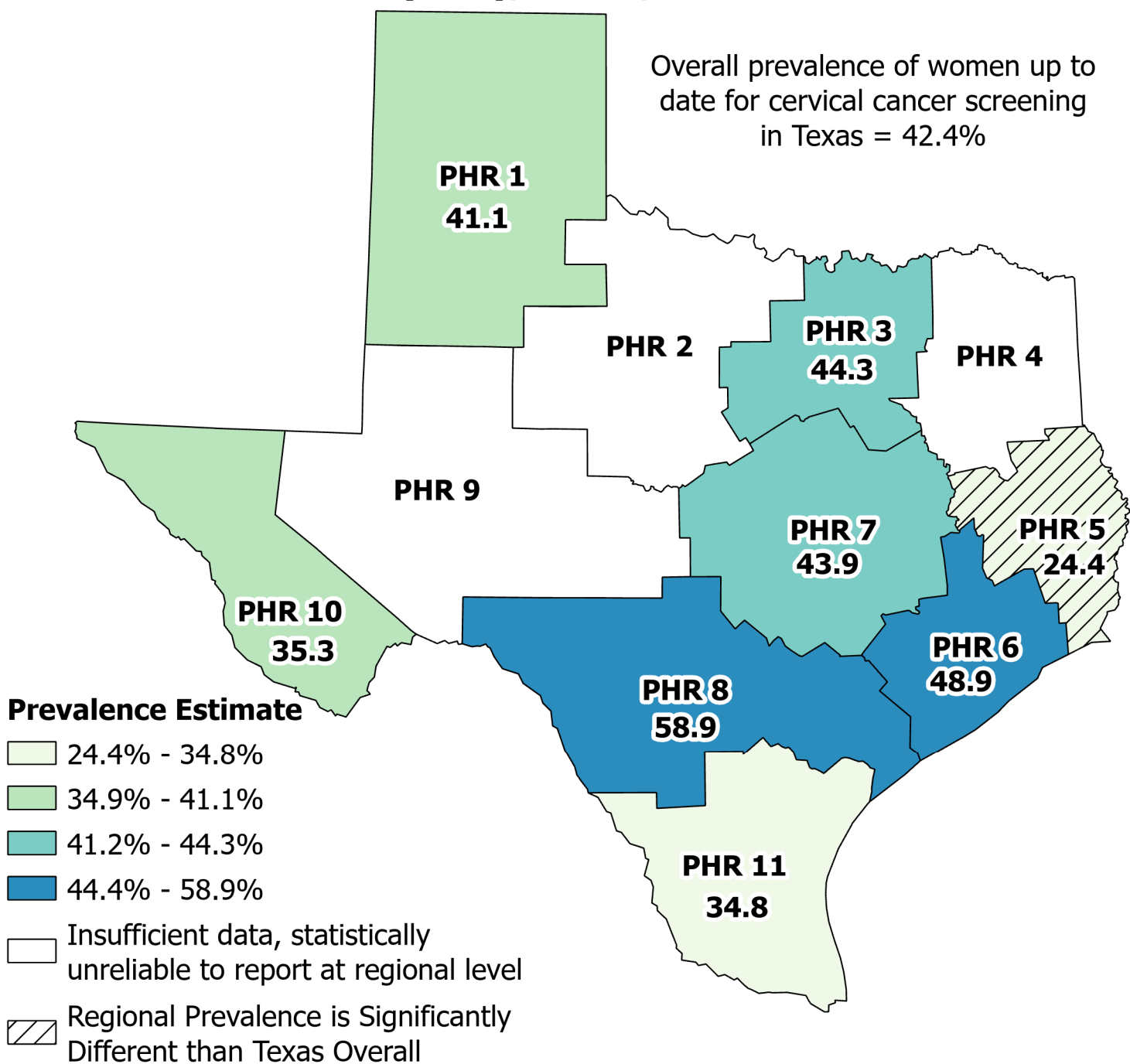


Prevalence of Women, Aged 21-65, Who Report Being Up To Date With Cervical Cancer Screening By Public Health Region (PHR), Texas, 2022

Overall prevalence of women up to date for cervical cancer screening in Texas = 42.4%

Up to date on cervical cancer screening recommendations is defined as: "Yes" responses to the question, "Have you ever had a cervical cancer screening test?" AND either responses of "Yes" and "Within the past 3 years" to the questions, "At your most recent cervical cancer screening, did you have a Pap test?" and "How long has it been since you had your last cervical cancer screening test?" OR responses of "Yes" and "Within the past 5 years" to the questions, "At your most recent cervical cancer screening, did you have an HPV test?" and "How long has it been since you had your last cervical cancer screening test?" OR responses of "Yes" to both the Pap and HPV question with a response of "Within the past 5 years" to the question, "How long has it been since you had your last cervical cancer screening test?" among females who reported their age to be 21-65 years old and who have not had a hysterectomy.
